Sub: Retention of savings with CIG.-Reg.

Ref: Circular No. F-1(66)RD/DPIP/2002 dated 08.01.03.

This is in continuation of point no. 3 at page no. 6-7 of above referred circular wherein it was clarified that if a sub-project completed below stipulated ceiling and it also fulfills all its parameters decided in this regard than the savings so done by the CIG members can be retained with themselves. Now it is again reiterated that if CIG has completed a sub-project below sanctioned amount due to any reason like hard labour of CIG members or any other reasons, favorable working conditions, better usages of material, introduction of new techniques, etc. than the savings so done should be kept with CIG members. The members of CIGs are fully authorized to retain such savings. In any case, CIGs should not be asked to return the savings if any. However, the CIG may use these savings for purchasing of machine & tools, any type of construction, modification, etc. to further strengthen the sub-project.
